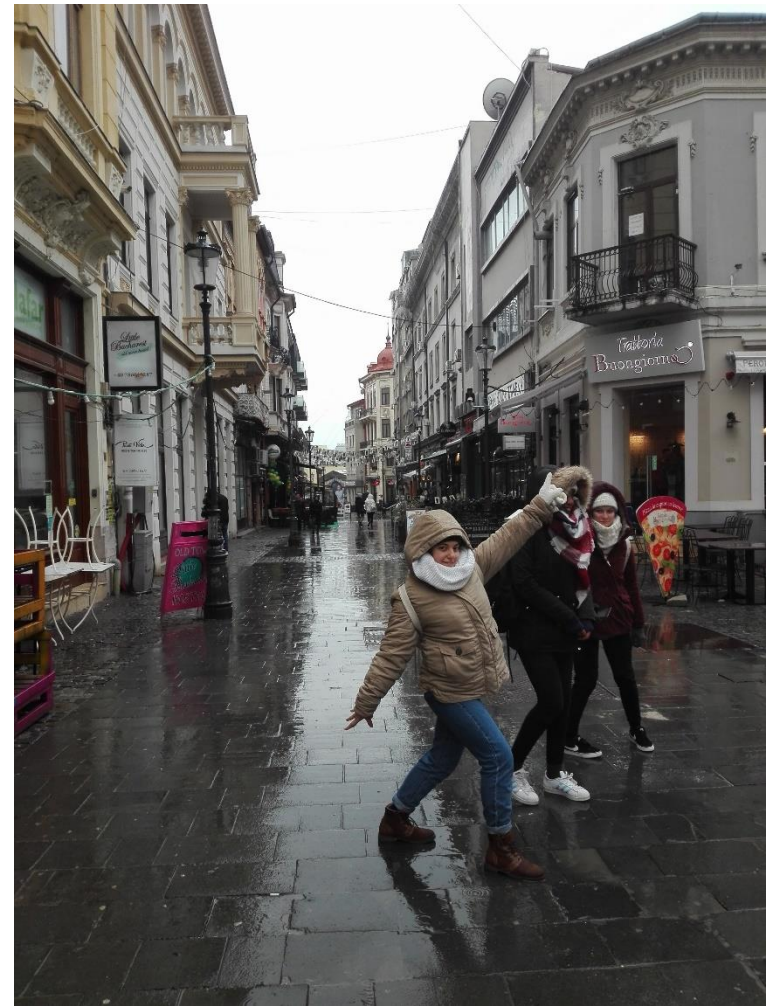

They were all waiting for us, at Scoala Gimnaziala Butea, the headmistress, Mrs Greta Predoi, was so happy and proud to welcome us all.

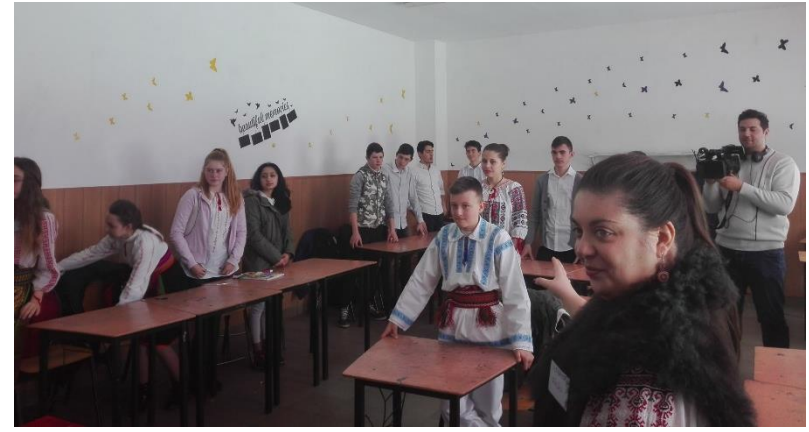
